

WARRANT  
FOR THE SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
MAY 11, 2010  
TOWN OF AQUINNAH  
COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

To either of the Constables of the Town of Aquinnah:

**GREETINGS:**

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Aquinnah who are qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet at the Aquinnah Old Town Hall in said Town on the Eleventh day of May 2010, at 6:45 PM, then and there to act upon the articles of this Warrant.

ARTICLE ONE  
Town Accountant

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from free cash the sum of \$3,000 (Three thousand dollars) for the purchase and installation of a computer and accessories in the Accountant's Office, or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE TWO  
Board of Selectmen

To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the unexpended balance of \$11,000 in STM 6-3-09, Article 14, FY2008 Audit Services, the sum of \$4,000 (Four thousand dollars) for the audit of FY2009 Town finances to be used in conjunction with previously appropriated funds in the FY2010 town operating budget expense line, or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE THREE  
Highway/Public Works

To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the remaining balance of \$7,000 in STM6-3-09, Article 14, the sum of \$7,000 (Seven thousand dollars) for the purchase of a new ride-on lawn mower and attachments, or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE FOUR  
Town Accountant

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from free cash the sum of \$4,326 (Four thousand three hundred twenty-six dollars) to purchase perpetual access rights to the current Business Management Systems, Inc. accounting software program, or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE FIVE  
Board of Selectmen

To see if the town will vote to appropriate from free cash the sum of \$4,000 (Three thousand dollars) to pay for plumbing and electrical repair services for the Circle restrooms, and install electrical service for the Philbin Beach attendant's shed, or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE SIX  
Town Assessor

To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the unexpended balance of ATM5-13-08, Article 13, FY2009 Interim Reval, the sum of \$1,600 (One thousand six hundred dollars) to the FY2010 Assessors/Expense line item for part of the cost of the VADAR Systems bridge software program, or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE SEVEN  
Board of Selectmen

To see if the Town will vote to establish the part-time position of Administrative Accounting Clerk not to exceed five hours per week during FY2010, nor 8 hours per week during FY2011, or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE EIGHT  
Board of Selectmen

To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Fund 282 Waterways Improvement the sum of **\$8,000** (Eight thousand dollars) to maintain the town's Menemsha and Squibnocket great ponds and their access, or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE NINE  
Library Trustees

To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the Special State Revenue Fund for the Library Incentive Grant the sum of **\$999.81** (Nine hundred ninety-nine dollars and eighty-one cents) to cover an inadvertent deficit incurred in the FY2009 Library/Wage line, or take any other action relative thereto.  
Nine-tenths vote required for passage.

ARTICLE TEN  
Board of Selectmen

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from the Capital Buildings and Grounds Stabilization Fund the sum of **\$2,910** (Two thousand nine hundred ten dollars) to pay an outstanding FY2010 bill for remedial computer and electrical wiring needed to complete the library restoration project, or take any other action relative thereto.  
Two-thirds vote required for passage.

ARTICLE ELEVEN  
Town Treasurer

To see if the Town will vote to transfer from free cash the sum of **\$12,000** (Twelve thousand dollars) to the Unemployment Insurance line in the FY2010 operating budget, or take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE TWELVE  
Board of Health

To see if the town will vote to appropriate from free cash the sum of **\$7,480** (Seven thousand four hundred eighty dollars) to pay for additional gas monitoring installation and landfill gas characterization at the Aquinnah Landfill, or take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE THIRTEEN**  
**Community Preservation Committee**

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate monies, from the Community Preservation Undesignated Reserve, for the undertaking of the following Historic Preservation projects, as recommended by the Community Preservation Committee:

**\$5,000** (Five thousand dollars) from the Community Preservation Undesignated Reserve for the installation of a new, historically appropriate door, jamb and storm/screen unit for the Aquinnah Library replacing the existing south-side entry. Disbursal of funds to be contingent on receiving all necessary approvals from Town Boards, and;

**\$15,000** (Fifteen thousand dollars) from the Community Preservation Undesignated Reserve for FY2010 mortgage costs related to the Edwin Vanderhoop Homestead,

or take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE FOURTEEN**  
**Community Preservation Committee**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer to the Community Preservation Housing Reserve, the unexpended balance of **\$7,700** (Seven thousand seven hundred dollars) from ATM 5-9-07, Article 10, for pre-development costs related to Town Center Rental Housing, or take any other action relative thereto.

And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copies at the Schoolhouse Library and Town Hall in said Town, at least fourteen days prior to time of said meeting. Hereof, fail not, and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at the time and place of said meeting.
